Hoboken Recreation Rules - Boys 5th-6th Grade Division

- 1. **Game Length:** Two 20-minute halves with a running clock.
- 2. Clock Stoppage: The clock will stop only during the last one minute of each half.
- 3. **Coaching Staff:** Each team is allowed a maximum of **two coaches** on the bench.
- 4. Timeouts: Each team receives two timeouts per half.
- 5. Substitution Whistle: There will be a mandatory substitution whistle at the 10-minute mark of the first half.
- 6. Roster Size for Substitution:
 - If a team has fewer than 10 players, at the substitution whistle, the opposing coach will
 choose which players remain on the bench for the 2nd quarter.
- 7. **Pressing:** No pressing is allowed until the **last minute of each half**.
- 8. **Press Violations:** Each team receives **one press warning per half**. Each additional infraction results in a **one-shot technical foul**.
- 9. **Overtime:** During the regular season, there will be **one 3-minute overtime period**. Each team receives **one timeout** during overtime.
- 10. **Personal Fouls:** Each player is allowed **five fouls**. Upon the 5th foul, the player is disqualified for the remainder of the game.

11. Team Fouls:

- o **7 team fouls:** One-and-one free throws.
- o 10 team fouls: Two free throws for the remainder of the half.
- 12. Playoff Eligibility, Seeding & Rules: to be determined by Rec Department.

13. Age Group Eligibility:

- A player may only participate in one age group, unless granted special permission by the Recreation Department.
- If a player is found to have participated in two age groups without permission, all games they played in will be counted as forfeits, and a loss will be added to both teams' records.

14. Substitutions

- All substitutes must report to the scorer's table prior to entering the game
- Players that play in the 1st quarter of the game cannot play in the 2nd quarter.
- If a team has less than 10 players, the opposing coach will select the players to remain on the bench in the 2nd quarter.

• In the 2nd half of the game, substitutions are at the coach's discretion.

Miscellaneous

- From the 7th team foul in a half, 1&1 free throws are awarded. From the 10th team foul in a half, (2) free throws are awarded.
- All players must wear the jersey issued at the beginning of the season. If a player does not have the appropriate jersey, a (1) shot technical foul will be awarded to the opposing team. The shot will be taken during half-time.
- Shoelaces: If a player's shoelaces become untied during play, the referee will direct the player to the bench. The game will continue play 5 on 4. Once the player's shoes are tied he/she will report to the scorer's table and re-enter the game at the next stoppage.
- A player committing (5) personal fouls will be disqualified from the game.
